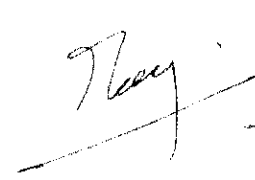

Topic	Subtopics
Fundamentals of Nursing	Nursing process, nursing ethics, communication skills, nursing care plan and professional responsibilities
Basic Nursing Procedures	Medication administration, injections, catheterization, oxygen therapy, specimen collection and patient care
Human Anatomy and Physiology	Cardiovascular, respiratory, nervous, endocrine, digestive and reproductive systems
Microbiology and Infection Control	Microorganisms, sterilization, disinfection, biomedical waste management and infection prevention
Pharmacology	Drug classification, dosage calculation, antibiotics, analgesics, vaccines and emergency drugs
Medical Surgical Nursing	Respiratory, cardiovascular, renal, gastrointestinal and neurological disorders
Midwifery and Gynecological Nursing	Pregnancy, labour, postnatal care, newborn care, family planning and gynecological conditions
Pediatric and Mental Health Nursing	Child health, immunization, pediatric emergencies, psychiatric disorders and counseling
Community Health Nursing	Primary health care, immunization programmes, maternal and child health and national health programmes
Basic Life Support	High-Quality CPR, the Chain of Survival, AED protocols, Foreign Body Airway Obstruction (choking), and rescue breathing
